Constitution of the Bharat Education Society



1. The Society shall be called 'BHARAT EDUCATION SOCIETY'
2. The office of the Society shall be situate in Bombay.
3. The aims and objects of the society are :—
 - (a) To start or take over existing educational institutions, such as schools and colleges, to start or take over libraries and reading rooms, to impart education to persons of both sexes with a view to making them ideal, self-supporting and God-fearing citizens.
 - (b) To spread, facilitate and cheapen education amongst all classes of the society.
 - (c) To raise the status of the members of the teaching profession in society and to improve their economic condition.
 - (d) To change and improve the prevailing methods of education, in accordance with the latest theories of education.
 - (e) To encourage the development of physique of the rising generation by starting physical cultural institutions.
 - (f) To erect, conduct and run hostels and recreational centres for students.
 - (g) To purchase, take on lease, exchange or acquire any movable or immoveable property and any rights or privileges necessary or convenient for the purposes of the Society.
 - (h) To erect, construct, alter or maintain any buildings or structures necessary or convenient for purposes of the Society.

- (i) To mortgage or charge or lease or transfer by sale, gift, exchange or otherwise, the whole or any part of the property or rights of the Society.
 - (j) To raise funds, accept and give donations, scholarships, freships, concessions in school fees and other help.
 - (k) To do all such other things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above aims and objects.
- 4 Unless there is something repugnant in the subject or the context,
- (a) "Society" means "The Bharat Education Society"
 - (b) "Year" means the academic year beginning from first of April to thirty-first March of the following year.
 - (c) "Office" means the Registered Office of the Society.
 - (d) "Rules" means the Rules and Regulations of the Society and shall include any Bye-laws made under these Rules.
 - (e) "Person" includes a male or a female but not an Institution.
 - (f) "Member" means a member of the Bharat Education Society.
- 5 The Society shall consist of (a) Patrons (b) Life Members and (c) Ordinary Members.
- 6 Any adult person who contributes rupees two hundred or more but less than rupees one thousand either in lump sum or by instalments in a period of one year from the date of his application for enrolling himself as an ordinary Member of the Society, and whose application shall be accompanied by at least an amount of Rs. 50 and has been sanctioned by the Governing Council will be enrolled as an Ordinary Member of the Society.
- 7 Any adult person who contributes rupees one thousand or more to the funds of the Society either by lump sum or by instalments within a period of one year from the date of his application for enrolling himself as a patron and whose application for becoming a patron is accompanied by at least a sum of
